The center provides UCD students with free tutorial services. We have both weekly appointment (Scheduled Tutoring) and Open Lab (walk-in basis). Since Open Lab tutoring starts on the second week of class, we would appreciate it if you would share this information with your students so they can take advantage of this service immediately. Attached please find a schedule of Open Lab sessions we have available for your students. Students can also request for permanent weekly scheduled tutoring. Additionally, the center provides UCD students with free Supplemental Instruction (SI) for selected courses, study skills, ESL help, and language conversation groups throughout each term.
